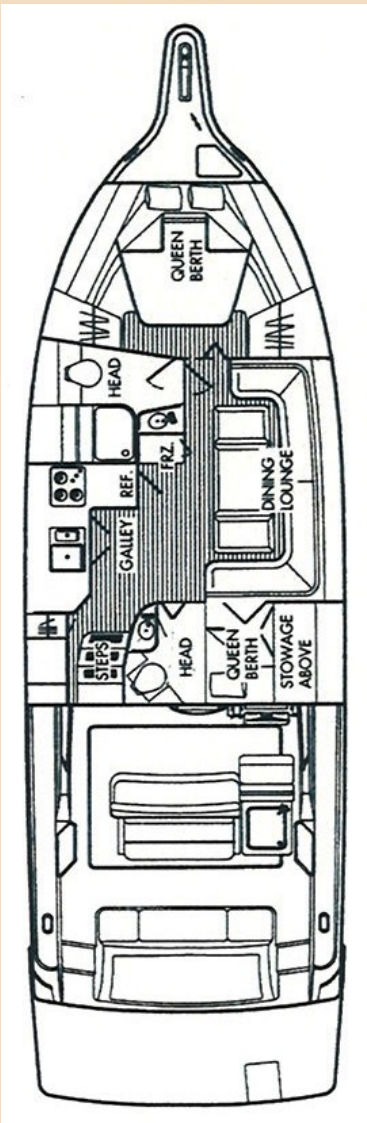


# 40' Tiara 4000 Express
